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School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Ravenna Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Superintendent Greg Helmer for assistance.

For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Based on the School Index Report Ravenna Middle School has not been identified as a targeted school at this time. The following data is from 2018-19 because due to COVID-19 in 2019-2020: RMS scored 61.03 in the Overall Category. A 58.68 in the Growth Index. A 62.52% in the Proficiency Index. A 58.07% in the School Quality and Student Success and 100% in the Assessment Participation overview. We continue to have a focus on climate and culture tied to our PBIS focus and PRIDE program. In February, we complete student, staff, and parent surveys for our comprehensive school assessment. Our PLC groups further examine data, and look at ways to improve the delivery of instruction. We believe that these changes will address the achievement gap that exists in our data. RMS has developed an intervention hour and Zero Hour, to address the intervention needs of our students along with meeting the needs of the rest of our student population.

- 1. Due to the fact that we have one middle school building in the district, all students are assigned to the same building. Students are assigned to classes based on their grade level and academic need, as determined by data gathered from multiple data sources.
- 2. During the 2020-2021 school year, we continued to build on the foundation that was established in the previous year. We continue to collaborate with our District School Improvement Team and our goal for the 2021-2022 school year is identified in MICIP as ELA. RMS has identified strategies in the District MiCip plan which they are working on as a building and are being monitored by the Building School Improvement Team and reported to the District School Improvement Team.
- 3. We are a 5-8 middle school building in a rural setting in Muskegon County. We currently offer intervention programs in reading and math at all grade levels. An accelerated math program is offered to students who demonstrate high levels of competency on math assessments and classroom academic test/grade data.
- 4. Our core curriculum is based on the state grade level expectations and the Common Core. This is implemented at each grade level, and assessed yearly through district and state assessments. Content pacing guides, unit plans, and lesson plans are digitized and housed in Google and Planbook. Curriculum information can be requested through the school office.
- 5. Beacon Testing in 2019-2020. STAR Testing due to COVID-19 in 2020-2021.

6. During the 2020-21 school year, Ravenna Middle School hosted non-traditional Parent Teacher Conferences via Google Meet and Phone Conferences. Parents were able to sign

up via Google Forms and for those who did not participate, emails were sent to parents to offer additional support through weekly updates per grade level.

In summary, We continue to strive for increased student achievement, while closing the gap between our top and bottom performers including the impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic. Our PLC staff collaboration continues to review student, staff, and parent surveys that are given each year to make improvements in our school. We celebrate our PRIDE and 5 Star Students quarterly by partnering with community groups to support our students. We are currently receiving CHAMPS training as a district during PD days and these strategies are being implemented in our classrooms. This is being done along with focusing our teaching and learning strategies on improving our ELA student achievement as outlined in MICIP.
