Dear Staff, Parents, and Community of Ravenna Public Schools:

The frequency of COVID-19 cases and quarantines are on the rise. I am aware of an alarming number of community members who have tested positive, or currently placed in quarantine. Obviously, our data only reflects students and employees. I would like to direct your attention to the following points:

- 1. Since last week's update, posted on our <u>website</u>, which is updated each Friday, we have been informed of several updates over the weekend.
- 2. Current data Updates on positive COVID-19 cases and quarantines in our District:

a. Beechnau Elementary

- i. 1 employee tested positive, in isolation
- ii. 4 students in quarantine, pending test results Includes close contact(s)

b. Middle School

- i. 1 employee in quarantine, pending test results Close contact tested positive
- ii. 4 students in quarantine, pending test results Includes close contact(s) testing positive

c. High School

- i. 1 employee tested positive, in isolation
- ii. 1 affiliated adult tested positive, in isolation
- iii. 1 student tested positive, in isolation
- iv. 1 employee in quarantine, pending test result Close contact tested positive
- v. 4 students in quarantine, pending test results Includes close contact(s) testing positive

d. District Wide

- i. Several staff and students monitoring for symptoms, self-screening daily
- ii. We have several students showing symptoms, not in attendance, monitoring for symptoms, self-screening daily
- 3. Due to a significant spike in positive cases of COVID-19 and the number of community members in quarantine, please read a joint statement by Superintendents from Muskegon, Ottawa, and Kent Counties:
 - a. Superintendent's Message

We will continue to work with Public Health - Muskegon County, and we will follow their recommendations regarding thresholds for maintaining in-person instruction, quarantining, isolation, identifying close contacts, and cleaning/sanitizing protocols.

We believe we are taking appropriate measures to prevent the spread of illness and we appreciate your efforts as well. As a reminder, continue to screen for symptoms. I truly believe it's our civic responsibility to effectively <u>screen</u> and quarantine during this pandemic.

Please be reminded that wearing a mask, following 6' physical distancing measures, limiting social gatherings, and frequently washing your hands is essential. Thank you for your partnership in keeping our students, staff, and community safe and healthy.
