 \Rightarrow Leave home early arrive at bus stop on time.




 \Rightarrow Wait for the bus in a safe place—off roadway



 \Rightarrow Follow the instruc-

- tions of your bus driver
- Carrying the most "precious" cargo daily.
- \Rightarrow Remain seated at all times
- ⇒ Keep aisles clear and unobstructed
- ⇒ Wait for the bus driver to signal before you cross the road
- \Rightarrow Go directly home—do not go to the mailbox
- \Rightarrow Ride only your assigned bus to and from school.

Stay out of the Danger Zone!!!



Bus Conduct Rules:

- 1. Follow the bus driver's direction the 1st time they are given.
- 2. Remain seated at all times.
- 3. Keep all body parts and objects inside the bus.
- 4. No eating, drinking or smoking allowed on bus.
- 5. Respect the rights, properties, and space of others.
- Items brought on bus must be held on lap (e.g. books, backpacks, musical instruments, etc.) Items may not block aisle or emergency exit.
- 7. Use appropriate language at all times.
- 8. Use a normal, "indoor", talking voice. Yelling and/or screaming is distracting to the driver.
- 9. Bus drivers may assign seats for any reason at any time.
- 10. Vandalism will not be tolerated (e.g. writing on seats, cutting/disfiguring seats, etc).
- 11. No Pets will be transported on the school bus.

Fall Notices:

Prior to the start of school, information will be mailed giving you the bus stop location, pick up and drop off times. Please have your students at the bus stop 10 minutes early.

School Cancellations or Delays:

Notices to cancel or delay school will be made prior to 6:00 a.m. Television stations WOTV 8, FOX 17 and WZZM13 are the channels that serve our district with the most accurate information. Our school district also utilizes an automated calling/email system to notify parents as well.

Early Release:

If it becomes necessary to release students from school early, announcements will be made on the above mentioned radio and television stations. The school district will also utilize the automated calling system to notify parents of this event. Students will be taken to their normal p.m. drop off point.

ECSE & Kindergarten Students:

According to Board of Education Policy, a parent, guardian or designee must be 'visible' at the drop off point to receive the child. ECSE students must be received at the door of the school bus.

Bullying:

How do I recognize Bullying?

- Aggressive behavior that causes mental or physical harm
- Involves an imbalance of power
- Is repeated over time.
- There is a bully and a victim

Bullying or Conflict?

Conflict is:

- When both parties are equal and they share the blame
- Usually a one-time event

Examples of Bullying:

- Hitting, slapping, elbowing	-Shoving
-Kicking	-Restraining
-Pinching	-Stealing
-Damaging belongings	-Name Calling, Teasing
-Insulting Remarks	-Put downs
-Racist remarks	-Threats
-Intimidation	-Destroying Reputation
-Humiliating/Embarrassment -Gossiping about others	
-Spreading Rumors/Lies	-Excluding people
